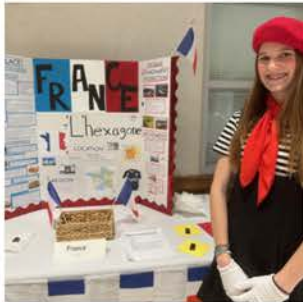


European Culture Feast

We've also been learning about Animal Habitats in preparation for our field trip to the San Antonio Zoo.



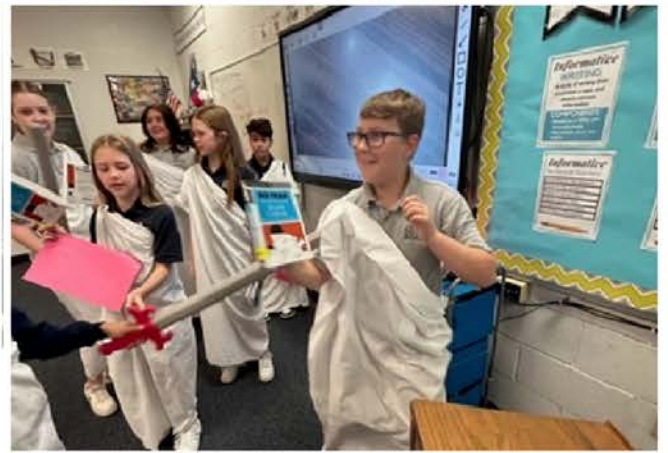
4th Grade

4th grade scholars enjoyed their field trip with 5th graders listening to the Corpus Christi Symphony Orchestra perform at TAMU-CC.

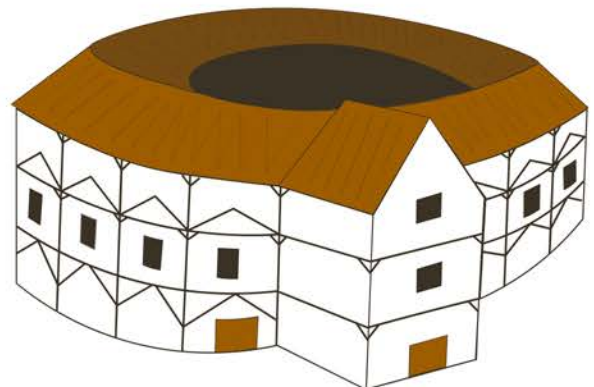


MIDDLE SCHOOL

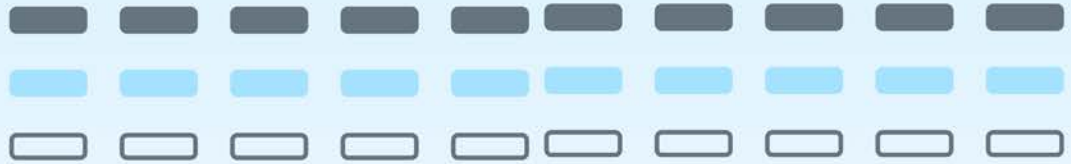

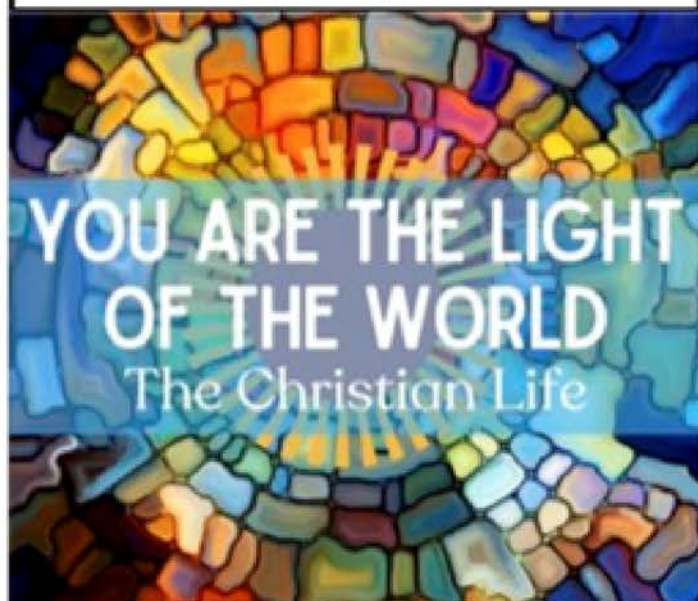
